A. Those that fall in the following categories will be allowed to enter Korea without a visa.

<b>Countries under visa waiver agreements (Maximum period of stay)</b>
Malaysia(3 Months), Romania(3 Months), Turkey(3 Months)
<b>Designated visa-free entry (Maximum period of stay)</b>
Japan(90 days), United States(90 days), Canada (6 months)

### ④ Poster Submission

-Posters will be displayed at the board during the Olympiad. Please summarize your presentation in a poster (**90 cm x 120 cm**).

-Posters should be designed for clear viewing from a distance of beyond 1~2 meters so that they can be viewed by a number of people at the same time.

-To ensure visual effectiveness of your poster, use large lettering and a minimum of text.

-Use of color can visually enhance your poster.

**-You should print out your poster and bring it with you.**

-You may **NOT** use your PPT Presentation slides as it is. Please be sure to make **"a poster for posting on the board"** according to the designated size (90 cm x 120 cm).
